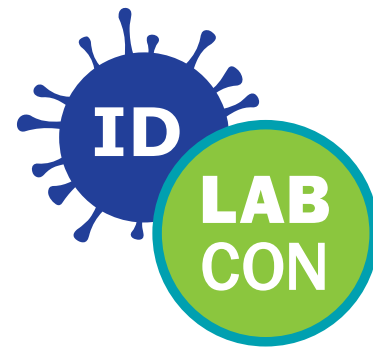


Travel Scholarships for Preconference Workshops

- Attendees from organizations planning to implement new testing technologies or approaches related to these workshops

At this time APHL plans to select around 35 scholarship recipients, but if more funding becomes available, we will select additional applicants from this pool.

Antimicrobial Resistance Testing in Diagnostic Laboratories Workshop

This workshop will cover the latest in emerging antimicrobial resistance pathogens, breakpoint implementation and use of molecular tests to identify mutations associated with resistance.

Next Generation Sequencing in the Microbiology Laboratory Workshop

This workshop will discuss how to implement NGS most effectively in the microbiology laboratory and communicate results including discussions on approaches to implementing NGS testing in compliance with CLIA requirements.

HIV, HCV and Syphilis Diagnostic Testing Workshop

This workshop will provide information on the latest testing algorithms and methodologies for HIV, HCV and Syphilis testing, based on recommendations from CDC and guidance from APHL.

Parasitology Workshop

This workshop will focus on diagnostic aspects of human parasitic infection including morphologic and molecular identification of parasites common to the US.
