DESCRIPTION

APHL's Overdose Biosurveillance Peer-to-Peer Exchange Program is launching to strengthen public health laboratory capabilities in non-fatal overdose biosurveillance.

Through this program, laboratory staff are matched for in-person peer exchanges based on their self-identified strengths and areas for growth. These exchanges are designed to:

- Share effective practices and procedures
- Address laboratory challenges
- Foster collaboration and engagement between programs for a stronger overdose biosurveillance system
