APHL's Chemical Threat (CT) Peer-to-Peer Exchange Program is entering its second year to strengthen public health laboratory capabilities in chemical threat preparedness across the country.

Through this program, CT Coordinators are matched for in-person peer exchanges based on their self-identified strengths and areas for growth. These exchanges are designed to:
