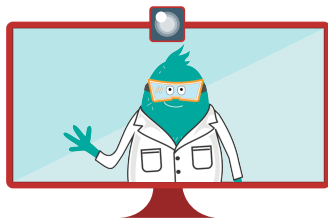

REVIEW & INTERVIEW

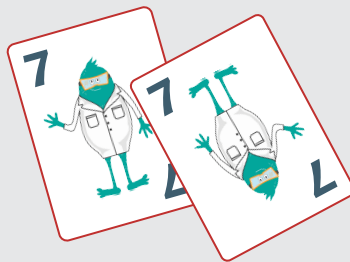


APHL reviews mentor applications. Approved mentors review and interview qualified fellow candidates.

APHL reviews the mentor's feedback post-interview. APHL facilitates a mentor-fellow match.

ONBOARDING



Upon contract completion, the onboarding process begins at the host laboratory.

 Start dates depend on host laboratory and fellow's possible relocation

MENTOR APPLICATION DETAILS

1 APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Resume or CV
- Laboratory mentoring experience
- Host laboratory description
- Describe intended project details
- Indicate desired fellow qualifications

 1-2 Hours depending on candidate

2 REVIEW & INTERVIEW

APHL will review all mentor applications weekly. Mentors are selected based on their application requirements as well as their ability to:

- Commit to 1-2 years (1 year minimum)
- Offer an in-person fellowship
- Provide the fellow with time to complete their APHL training curriculum
- Support the fellow's attendance in professional development and the annual APHL conference

Approved mentors will be given access to review the fellow candidate pool where they may filter and select desired fellow applicants.

3 MATCHING

Mentors interview selected fellow candidates and provide interview feedback to APHL to facilitate a mentor-fellow match.

The host laboratory/mentor and prospective fellow agree upon a start date and intended project.

APHL formalizes a contract with the fellow.

 Within two weeks

4 ONBOARDING

Fellow relocates to host laboratory.

Fellow receives onboarding resources and fulfills requirements specific to the host laboratory and APHL.

Fellow and mentor begin the fellowship program.

APHL will provide ongoing resources and support to both the mentor and fellow throughout the entirety of the fellowship program.
