Where is the conference being held?

AMD Days 2024 will be held at the Decatur Conference Center connected to the Courtyard by Marriott Decatur Downtown/Emory Hotel, 130 Clairemont Avenue, Decatur, GA. It is in downtown Decatur, walking distance to numerous restaurants, shops and entertainment.

Will any sessions be live streamed for AMD Days 2024?

Yes, select sessions occurring in the Decatur Ballroom will be available to attend virtually. If you are interested in attending sessions virtually, please [register](#) to receive the meeting link. There is no cost to register.

Will recordings or slides of the presentations be available after the conference?

While slides will not be available, select presentation recordings will be available after the conference. Any recordings will be posted on the [AMD Days website](#) within four weeks of the conference close. Continuing education credits will not be available for conference recordings.

- Receive alerts, reminders and changes in real time.

What are the parking arrangements and directions?

Parking is available at the Courtyard by Marriott Decatur Conference Center Parking Garage for \$16 per day. The parking garage is located behind the Courtyard by Marriott at 10 Marshall Street, Decatur GA. If approaching from East Ponce de Leon Ave, take a right onto Clairemont Avenue, just past the Courtyard by Marriott entrance turn left onto Montgomery Street. Follow Montgomery Street past the Decatur Conference Center entrance and turn left onto Marshall Street following signs for conference center parking.

How do I connect to WIFI?

Complementary wireless internet is provided in the public areas of the hotel and conference center. To access, please connect to the **MarriottBonvoy_Guest** network. No password is required.

Will continuing education credits be available?
