



K0431 – Understanding the Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC) - Virtual

Course Dates:

March 14–17, 2022

Course Length:

This virtual course will be held over 4 consecutive days, March 14–17, 2022, from 12 noon–4 p.m. EST.

Course Description:

This course enables emergency management, response, and recovery personnel from all political jurisdictions to more effectively understand, activate, implement, and use the EMAC system. Due to the COVID-19 response, the Understanding the EMAC Course (K0431) will be conducted virtually via Abode Connect.

Goal:

The goal is to introduce emergency management, response, and recovery personnel to EMAC and the EMAC process so they can knowledgeably use the Nation's interstate mutual aid system.

Pre-Requisites:

None

Target Audience/Selection Criteria:

- Personnel from any jurisdiction or organization who can be legally deployed via EMAC, or
- Personnel from organizations who may request or provide assistance via EMAC, or
- Individuals desiring a more comprehensive working knowledge of EMAC

To Apply:

Participants must apply using the EMI online admissions system to gain access to the course.
